

## EEGA@Connections - Authors' Guidelines

*Latest version: October 2017*

The EEGA stimulates a research-led discourse on Eastern Europe and promotes knowledge transfers between science and the public. It builds and further strengthens an internationally visible infrastructure.

EEGA disseminates collaborative research results into academia by open access publications and into the public by organising public events and employing social media. For this dissemination the EEGA closely cooperates with the e-journal "Connections" (<http://www.connections.clio-online.net/>) in mutually profiting collaboration. The ScienceCampus EEGA publishes about two to three "EEGA@connections" issues every year and has its own column "EEGA in dialogue" on the "Connections" website. Members, guest researchers and EEGA-Postdoc fellows are invited to submit their project outlines and first findings for publication here. "Connections" also provides as a sort of newsletter important information to the EEGA community and publishes calls for applications and papers, announces events and reviews recent publications on a regular basis.

In addition, collections of selected short papers on a particular topic, e.g. from workshops and thematic kick-off meetings, are published with an introduction as PDF Working Papers, so called EEGA@connections Special Issues.

Articles from these "EEGA@Connections" Special issues will be published electronically as

- a) integrated text,
- b) PDF for download

on both the "[Connections](#)" and the [Leibniz ScienceCampus EEGA](#) websites.

The EEGA distinguishes between three different types of articles published in the cooperation with Connections:

1. Articles for a collection (Special issue)
2. Single articles (integrated texts)
3. Scientific reports (EEGA in dialogue)

All articles should include:

- Title
- abstract (max. **150** words)
- up to **6** keywords
- a short paragraph about the author (incl. institution and e-mail address, max. **150** words)

Whereas the articles which form part of a special issue concentrate on the discussion of the particular topic or issue, single articles by EEGA Postdoc Fellows and Guest Researchers shall feature both the discussion

of a current state of research as well as the depiction of the specific topic the researcher is currently working on. Shorter scientific reports in the column “EEGA in dialogue” are supposed to give a brief overview of the state of research followed by insights into the research project of the author.

The journal’s editors in cooperation with the Steering Committee of the Leibniz ScienceCampus EEGA decide upon the acceptance of submissions for publication and organize the peer-review process.

## Open Access

The "EEGA@Connections" series accepts articles in English, French, German and Russian.

All articles will be published under the open-access policy of the e-journal "Connections", for submission all authors must accept these rules.

With the submission of your text, you agree, if not otherwise stated, to publication in *Connections* and across the H-Soz-u-Kult, Clio-online and H-Net network.

Authors are allowed to post the published version on their personal/ departmental website as well as place it in their institution’s official repository by connecting to these websites.

Articles that form part of “EEGA@connections” Special Issues should not be published elsewhere (meaning identical versions with the same scope, format and argumentation), but may be revised, extended, broadened or shortened for other publication formats.

## Format

The length of articles should range from 2.500 to 6.000 words.

Please provide your manuscript only as a Word document (not as PDF).
