EEGA brings together interdisciplinary knowledge and expertise from researchers affiliated with universities and research institutes in Leipzig, Jena and Halle. Together with partners from the region, EEGA explores the fields of migration and mobilities, business strategies and political economies, cultural and intellectual perspectives and identities, and political integration in a changing global arena. Overcoming prejudices and clichés, some of which are rooted in the era of the Cold War, and promoting an informed understanding of Eastern Europe in its diverse traditions and positions, developments and internal dynamics are the primary mission.
